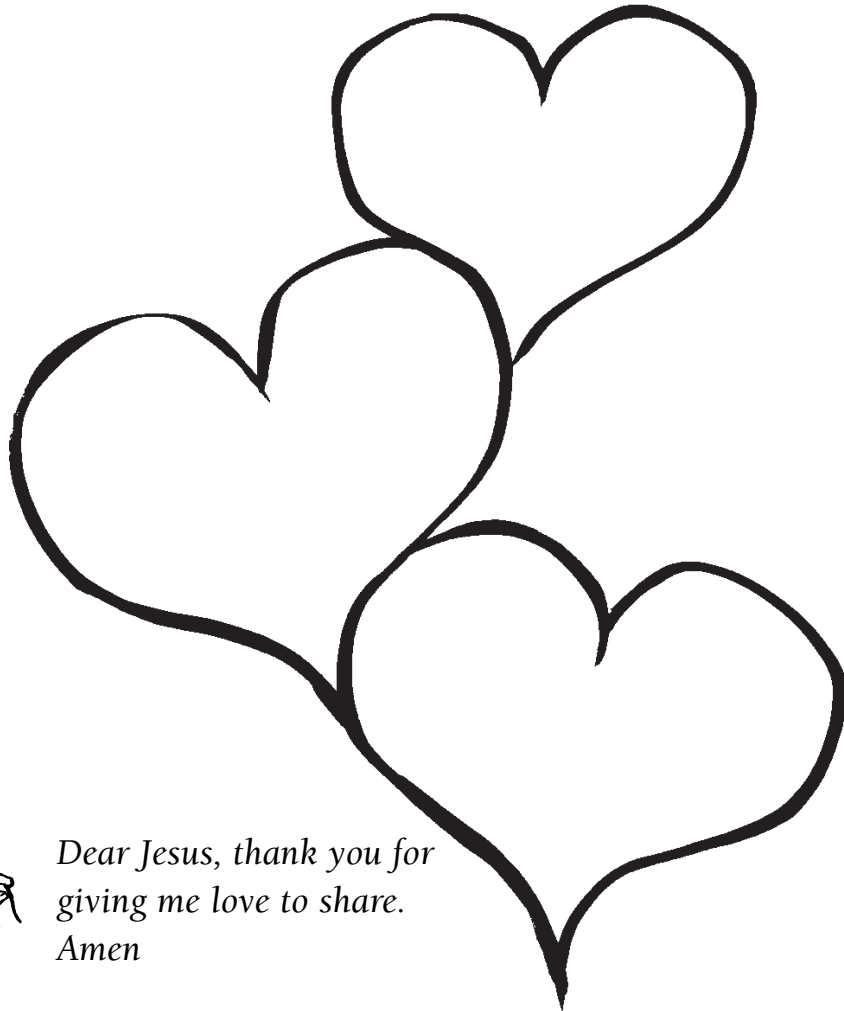

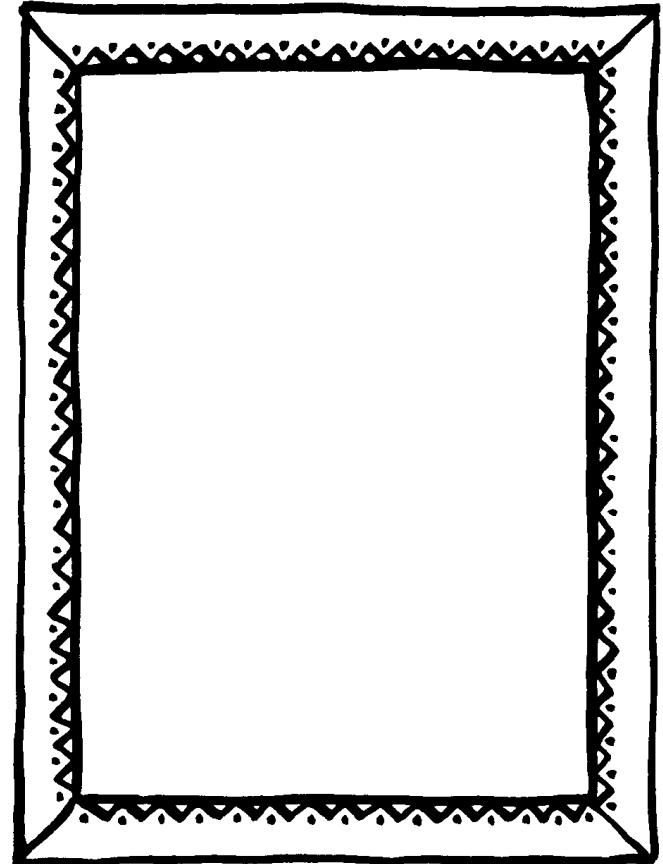
Fifth Sunday of Easter

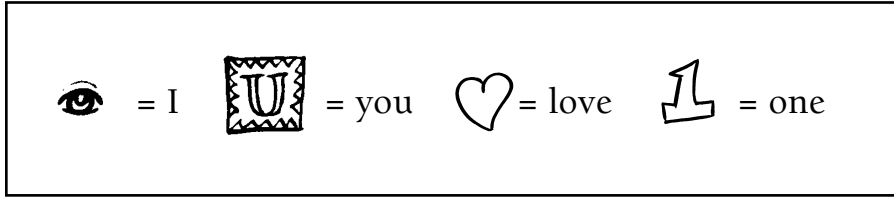
Draw a one-of-a-kind person sitting near you.

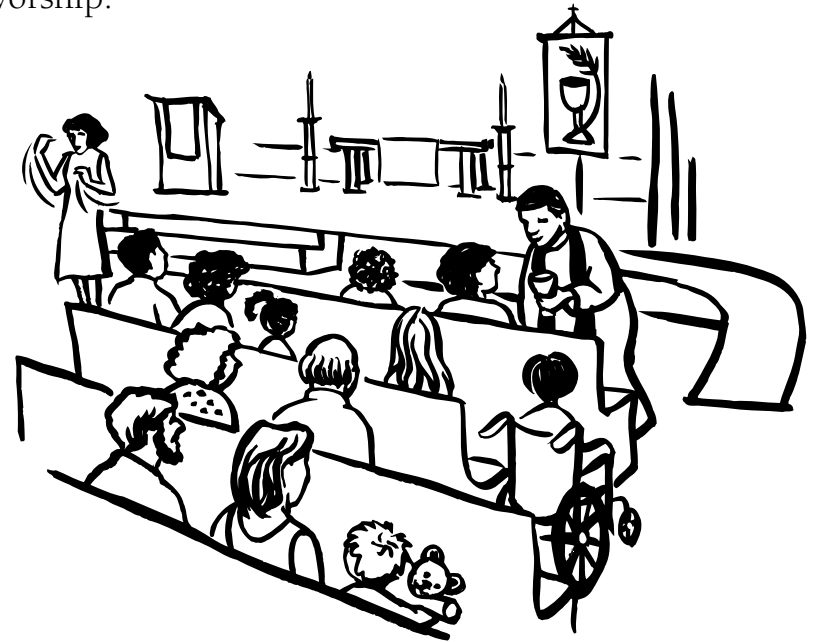
